



Hope Lutheran School Dress Code Policy

Shirts

Colors: Red, Burgundy, White, Navy, Blue, Yellow, Hunter or Kelly Green

Plain short or long sleeved buttoned shirt with a collar or turtleneck. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Shirts must not be unbuttoned more than one button below the collar. Only Hope logos are acceptable.

Sweater, sweatshirt, v-neck sweater, vest, or pullover fabric light jacket (fleece) must be worn with a collared shirt. Plain, solid color as listed above. Only Hope logos.

No outdoor jackets or hooded or zippered sweatshirts/jackets.

Belts

Plain brown or black leather belts or pants-matching cotton twill belts.

Pants or Shorts

Colors: Tan, Navy Blue, or Black

Belted or elastic waistband in cotton twill or corduroy slacks will be worn at natural waist.

Students in grades 2-8 will wear a belt for pants with belt loops.

No cargo style or jeans style of pants with rivets and/or pockets on legs.

Shorts may not be shorter than 3 inches above the knee.

Shorts allowed in August, September, October, April, May & June only.

Skirts, Shorts, & Jumpers

Colors: Tan, Navy Blue, Black or Plaid #55 or #66

Worn at natural waist without being rolled over.

May not be shorter than 3 inches above the knee.

Wear shorts or tights under skirts and jumpers.

Socks, Tights, Underwear

Colors: White, Tan, Navy Blue or Black

Pantyhose must be in natural colors

Socks, tights or pantyhose must be worn.

Underwear must be worn as intended and not visible.

Shoes

Colors: White, Brown, Navy Blue, or Black

Loafers, Oxfords, Mary Janes, or athletic shoes with non-marking soles

Shoes must be fastened/tied securely. Heels no higher than 1 inch.

Solid colors preferred.

Hair Accessories and Jewelry

Hair should be neat and not a distraction. Hair must be kept out of the student's eyes. Hair may not be colored in unusual colors. We discourage hair dye for students. Hairbands and scrunchies should be in uniform colors.

NO bandanas or scarves.

No hats or sunglasses may be worn in the building.

Earrings: No more than two posts per ear. No hoops or dangling earrings.

No other body parts may be pierced.

No bracelets.

No tattoos (permanent or temporary).

Anything else is considered unacceptable.
